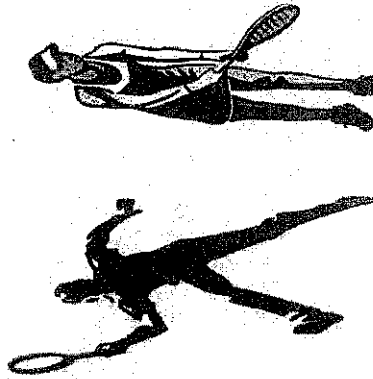


Leah Meehl

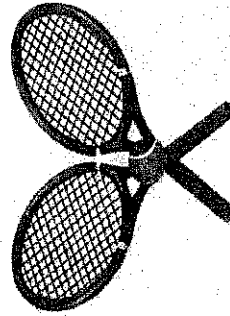
